

GROUND SAFETY RECOMMENDATION

Chocks & Cones

Remember:

Before the arrival of the aircraft chocks and cones must be positioned outside the ERA.


Do not place the chocks before all the engines and anti-collision lights are off.

Chocks should be positioned according to the rules of the Carrier;

- In case of lack of specific requirements chocks should be placed as follows: 2 under the front landing gear and 2 under the main landing gear (see opposite picture);
- The correct positioning of chocks must be confirmed to Cockpit -Crew by the Marshaller;
- After positioning chocks it is possible to place safety cones, as required by the Carrier. In case of lack of specific requirements cones should be placed: 1 under the end of each wing, 1 in front of each wing engine, 1 under the empennage (see opposite picture);

Chocks should be removed:

- according to the permission of the ramp operator responsible for the departure
- after removal of the loading bridge
- after connection of PUSH BACK (or TOW BAR tractor);



When finished, chocks and cones should be placed in an orderly manner outside the ERA and outside the movement area of the aircraft.

Important:

In case of decentralization of the aircraft, when the towing operation is over, chocks MUST be placed under the main landing gear of the aircraft, before disconnecting the tow bar (or the tow-barless) tractor.
