GROUND SAFETY RECOMMENDATION


Jet blast and Start Engines


For push-back operations of aircraft moving from STAND to TWY R and S, to avoid jet blast problems, the rules are as follows:

- ✓ All motors must be started only after the correct release position (Q Point) has been reached
- ✓ In the event that the APU is declared inoperative, it will be possible to authorise the start-up of a single engine in "idle power" at the stand
- ✓ Who is providing the assistance at the start up must ensure full safety conditions by observing the minimum distance of 150m from any obstacle behind the engines



Q Point allowed on TWY R and S: Q 10 (R) e Q6 (S):
