Procedures in adverse weather condizions- Strong wind

11.1.4 Adverse weather conditions notification

In case of strong wind

The Aerodrome Operator's Duty Manager officially notifies to all Air Side operators the weather conditions, urging them to quickly activate all necessary initiatives to prevent FOD's generation and also to verify that all vehicles and equipment are on safety.

After the "adverse weather condition" notification, **as soon as possible check that:**

- vehicles and equipment are well braked and/or with stabilizers down;
- there are no containers on the ground;
- the CNA material is properly stored ;
- there is no waste, of various kinds that become FOD;
- there is no abandoned cellophane



Remember:

Brake the equipment after you park it. In case of strong wind, an unbraked equipment can cause injury or damage an aircraft.

Bad practice can lead to accidents, even serious ones!
